1 John Review

1 John was written so that those who have believed in Jesus Christ may know that they have eternal life (1 John 5:13). Antichrists and false prophets were trying to deceive the children of God. A number of these deceivers had been in their church but later left the church. They were teaching "new truths" which were actually lies. John wanted "his children" to hold fast to the teaching which they heard from the beginning. John heard Jesus' teaching for three years. John saw Jesus' miracles. He saw Jesus die on the cross. He saw the resurrected Christ and his ascension into heaven. Followers of Jesus needed to listen to John instead of a group of people who did not know Jesus but who claimed to have special knowledge. John encouraged the recipients of the letter to be confident that they already knew God and that they knew the truth. They didn't need any new, special knowledge to know God. John gave them a number of tests to determine who truly were children of God and who were children of the devil.

Tests to determine who is a child of God and who is a child of the devil.

1. Doctrine – how does someone answer the question, "who is Jesus and why did Jesus come to earth"?
